1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), entitled "An act providing for the licensing of eligible organizations to conduct games of chance, for the licensing of persons to distribute games of chance, for the registration of manufacturers of games of chance, and for suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; requiring records; providing for local referendum by electorate; and prescribing penalties," in games of chance, providing for payment and for online raffle sales; and abrogating a regulation.

12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. The act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156),
14	known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, is amended
15	by adding sections to read:
16	Section 301.2. Payment.
17	(a) Methods
18	(1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) and
19	notwithstanding any other provision of law, a licensed
20	eligible organization may accept payment via credit card,
21	debit card, mobile payment services or other electronic
22	payment method for the playing of games of chance.

- 1 (2) A licensee under Chapter 9 may not accept mobile
- 2 payment services for the playing of games of chance.
- 3 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 5 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 6 "Mobile payment service." A service in which a money payment
- 7 <u>is made electronically through a money transfer service, such as</u>
- 8 <u>Venmo, Paypal, Cash App or an equivalent money transfer service.</u>
- 9 Section 303.2. Online raffle sales.
- 10 (a) Operations. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 11 act, a licensed eligible organization may conduct and reveal the
- 12 <u>winner of raffles through a publicly accessible Internet</u>
- 13 website, social media platform or mobile application.
- 14 (b) Payments. -- A licensed eligible organization may accept
- 15 <u>electronic payment via credit card, debit card, mobile</u>
- 16 <u>electronic payment application or other electronic payment</u>
- 17 method for the purchase of a raffle ticket, provided that the
- 18 <u>organization</u>:
- 19 (1) employs a method to detect the physical location of
- an individual who buys a ticket for the raffle. The
- 21 <u>organization may not accept payment from an individual who is</u>
- 22 located outside of this Commonwealth;
- 23 (2) employs a method to verify that the individual who
- buys a raffle ticket is at least 18 years of age. The
- 25 <u>organization may not accept payment from an individual under</u>
- 26 18 years of age; and
- 27 (3) does not violate the provisions of 31 U.S.C. Ch. 53
- 28 Subch. IV (relating to prohibition on funding of unlawful
- 29 <u>Internet gambling</u>).
- 30 (c) Applicability. -- The following sections shall not apply

1 to online raffle sales:

- 3 <u>(2) Section 303(b).</u>
- 4 <u>(3) Section 907.</u>
- 5 Section 2. The provisions of 61 Pa. Code § 901.506 are
- 6 abrogated insofar as they are inconsistent with the addition of
- 7 section 301.2 of the act.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
